BOARD OF DIRECTOR ELECTION AND ANNUAL MEETING NOTICE:

All members of Orlando Credit Union are invited to the 86th Annual Meeting of Orlando Credit Union. The 86th annual meeting will be conducted virtually and in-person at 5:00 pm on Thursday, April 21, 2022, at the Sodo branch, 945 South Orange Avenue, Orlando, FL 32806. Information and registration will be posted on our website.

Volunteer to serve on Orlando Credit Union's Board of Directors or Supervisory Committee. To be eligible, a prospective candidate must be a member in good standing of Orlando Credit Union, at least 18 years of age, willing and able to serve if elected. Board members are volunteers and are not paid for their time or service. Filing forms are available for download from our website or at any of our branch locations.

Late filing notice:

After 4 p.m. on Friday, January 14, 2022, members may have their names placed on the ballot by submitting a petition signed by at least 246 members in good standing. Petitions must be received by the Secretary of the Board of Directors no later than March 11, 2022. The names of those members nominated and the voting instructions will be available in 2nd Quarter's Edition of the "On the Money" newsletter

IMPORTANT CHANGE IN TERMS NOTICE EFFECTIVE 02/01/2022:

LIMITATION OF SERVICES; MEMBER IN GOOD STANDING

We may restrict account access and services without notice to you when your account is being misused; you have demonstrated conduct which is abusive in nature; as outlined in any policy we have adopted regarding restricting services; your account is not in good standing; or as otherwise permitted by law. Your account is not in good standing if 1) you are 30 days delinquent on any loan with the Credit Union; 2) you have caused any financial loss to the Credit Union; 3) you have any unresolved non-sufficient fund item outstanding, whether in regard to a deposit or otherwise; 4) you have any unpaid Credit Union fees or costs, including Safe Deposit Box fees owed to the Credit Union; 5) you have a negative balance on any account with the Credit Union; 6) you have committed fraud; 7) you have filed bankruptcy with us; 8) you have any legal orders outstanding on any account.

KEEPING YOUR ORLANDO CREDIT UNION ACCOUNTS ACTIVE:

We understand that accounts may go unused for many different reasons. You may have moved or simply forgotten you have an account with us. While we hope you will continue to use our services, we want you to keep your account active to avoid dormancy fees, and eventual escheatment to the State of Florida.

If your account has not had any activity such as a deposit, withdrawal, or loan payment, within a 12-month period, your account is considered dormant. After five (5) years of inactivity and no communication with Orlando Credit Union, we are required by state law to turn your account balances over to the State of Florida. *Applicable to minimum financing term of 24 months. Financing and rates are based on creditworthiness, term and year of vehicle. The cash back is paid based on 1% of the total loan amount financed, not including any add-on products such as mechanical repair insurance. The cash back will be deposited into the member's account within 30 days of the loan funding. Existing Orlando Credit Union vehicle loans are NOT ELIGIBLE for these offers. Offer not valid with other Orlando Credit Union promotional offers. If the loan balance is repaid in less than 24 months from the date of loan closing, the 1% Cash Back must be repaid to the Credit Union. The cash back amount will be added to the loan balance, and the then-current loan balance must be paid in full before (a) the loan will be deemed paid in full and (b) any lien on the loan collateral will be satisfied. All loans subject to credit approval. Cash back amounts are subject to all applicable taxes and are the responsibility of the member. If you participate in this offer, you may receive Form 1099 MISC at year-end for tax purposes. Certain terms and restrictions apply. Applicants must qualify for membership. As a condition of membership you must maintain at least \$5 in your Ownership Share Account. Offer valid December 1, 2021 through January 31, 2022 only.

*First payment will be due 90 days from loan origination. Interest will begin accruing as of the loan origination date, which will result in paying a higher total finance charge and will extend the loan term. Offer expires January 31, 2022. Offer not available on terms less than 24 months. Existing Orlando Credit Union vehicle loans are not eligible for this offer.
